Our educational program, PAWS that Empower, introduces the importance of Equality for all. Each student joins me outdoors on a blanket or grassy area as we acknowledge our difference and how we are the same! We discuss the perceived differences we step into situations with this newfound knowledge.



Our workshops are four or 6-week sessions covering that Tolerance, Kindness, Compassion, Integrity, Gratitude, Confidence, and Empathy. We read, talk; we share, listen, do art, and understand.

Disabilities DO NOT go away during a crisis, nor do service dogs. Education is vital. The discussion about realities and the pivotal points that we are sitting in the chair or using the tools for the movement allows us the confidence to leave the comfort zone of our homes for exploration. What changes the mind to move.

We will share a service dog or companion pet at their side and the other tools we can embrace for a broader experience. We will continue our Workshop with a Reading Circle presentation. Afterward, we will break into small groups to share the book.

When they join together to create an artistic rendering of our experience, each will be a unique expression of how they can own more of their lives.

We will discuss the confidence we gain when we can step into the joys and dreams of our making with or without a dog by our side. Community as we teach vital skills for living.

The students will learn the power of their minds and the strength of sharing. The audience will know that a Service Dog is a viable option and that a community with others to support the journey is a gift to themselves and their families. Acceptance will be presented.

I have presented Paws that Empower Workshop(s) to over 3900 humans since January 25, 2018.

We must live our life's dreams by our designs, allowing them to unfold —owning our abilities today. It would be an honor to introduce others to the



ownership of living vibrantly accepting our disabilities but not becoming them.

We will present different views of people living with disabilities and challenge others to draw upon all the experiences and how that can assist each of us with the confidence to embrace our successes and step into a community.

While we have so many unique devices giving us so much more hope, it is the rawness of drawing upon the perspective each has learned. It is not about starting over but continuing forward. To offer practical ideas that we can begin just being present-life-changing.
